Orff Lesson plan format

Grade Level: 3rd Grade

<u>Concept/ Curriculum Goal:</u> Students will develop a better understanding for improvising and making up different melodies.

Materials:

Music for Sun Don't Set in the Mornin' and Camptown Races

Barred Instrument

Computer and Projector

Lesson Outline:

I. Opening/Introduction:

Sun Don't Set in the Mornin'

- Speak the poem to the kids to get it fresh in their minds again
- Have them start tapping their knees in a four pattern

II. Presentation:

Sun Don't Set in the Mornin'

- Have the students clap out the rhythm in a repeat after me style
- Move them onto the Barred Instruments
- Tell them they can only play their Do, (F)
- Have them play the pattern with just the F
- Work through each measure with the kids, with the notes up on the board.
- Teaching them the actual song to the notes.
- Let them do improvising in an ABA formation as long as it starts on F and ends on F
- So the kids play the song, improvise then play the song again.

III. Exploration:

Start with a different song (Camptown Races)

- Have them use the same words but make up a different melody.
- If they change the starting note, help them figure out where they put the new do.
- Have them make up little actions to their new version in little groups.

IV. Culmination/Closing:

Have the kids perform their actions to the class, while the whole class also sings the song along with them.
